

FITTING INSTRUCTIONS FOR EH0072BK EXHAUST HANGER KTM SUPERDUKE GT '16-



THIS KIT CONTAINS THE ITEMS PICTURED AND LABELLED BELOW. DO NOT PROCEED UNTIL YOU ARE SURE ALL PARTS ARE PRESENT.

Please note that the way the kit is packed does not necessarily represent the way of mounting to the bike. The Parts shown may be representative only (for clarity of instructions only)

LEGEND

 $\overline{\text{ITEM 1}} = \overline{\text{EXHAUST HANGER (HB0072) (x1)}}$.


ITEM 2 = M8 x 25mm LONG BUTTON HEAD BOLTS (x2).

ITEM 3 = SPACERS (S0985 - 4mm LONG) (x2).

ITEM $4 = M8 \times 55 \text{mm}$ LONG BUTTON HEAD BOLT (x1).

ITEM 5 = M8 WASHERS (x2).

ITEM 6 = M8 NYLOC NUT (x1).



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
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TOOLS REQUIRED

- Set of metric Allen keys to include 5mm A/F sizes.
- Socket set to include 12 & 13mm socket & wrench.
 - T45 Torx socket.


Please note that in cases where kits are packed with rubber washers holding the components onto the bolt – *the rubber washers should be thrown away*!

FITTING INSTRUCTIONS

- To fit the R&G Exhaust Hanger, the OEM pillion footrest mounting bracket needs to be removed.
- To do this, remove the two mounting bolts at the top of the pillion footrest mounting bracket, as arrowed in picture
 1.
- Remove the exhaust mounting nut and bolt and then remove the OEM pillion footrest mount from the bike, as shown in picture 2.
- Take the R&G Exhaust Hanger and fit the two M8 x 25mm long button head bolts (item 2) through the two top mounts of the exhaust hanger and locate the two spacers (item 3 S0985 4mm long) onto the exposed thread of each bolt, before tightening into the threaded bosses on underside of the subframe, as shown in picture 3.
- With the exhaust hanger on the bike, ensure the lower part of the exhaust hanger is on the outside of the exhaust mounting bracket, and fit the remaining M8 x 55mm long button head bolt (item 4) with one M8 washer (item 5) through the exhaust hanger mounting hole and then through the exhaust bracket, before fitting the M8 washer (item 5) and M8 nyloc nut (item 6) onto the exposed thread of the bolt and loosely tighten, as shown in picture 4.
- Ensure the exhaust hanger is correctly fitted before tightening all three bolts.
- Please ensure when the motorcycle is being used that no parts are in such a position that they may collide/damage other bike parts (this is particularly important if using after-market cans or exhaust systems).

Please note that it is your responsibility to ensure that no part of the exhaust hanger or exhaust assembly fouls or comes into contact with other parts of the machine. Do not ride the motorcycle until this aspect has been verified and you have compressed the rear suspension (if appropriate to the design of the motorcycle) to test this thoroughly.

ARTICLE $4 = M8 \times 55 \text{mm BOULON } (x1)$.

ARTICLE 5 = M8 RONDELLES (x2).

ARTICLE 6 = M8 ECROU (x1).



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OUTILS REQUIS

- Clés Allen 5mm.
- Clé à douille 12 & 13mm.
 - Clé Torx T45 Torx.

Notez que si les kits sont emballés avec des rondelles en caoutchouc servant à tenir les composants, ces rondelles doivent être jetées!





NOTICE DE MONTAGE



- Pour monter le support d'échappement R&G, le support de fixation du repose pied passager d'origine doit être enlevé.
- Pour cela, enlever les 2 boulons de fixation situés au dessus du support de fixation repose pied passager, voir photo 1.
- Enlever l'écrou de fixation d'échappement et le boulon, puis enlever le support de repose pied passager de la moto, voir photo 2.
- Prendre le support d'échappement R&G et insérer les 2 boulons M8 x 25mm (article 2) dans les 2 supports supérieurs du support échappement puis placer 2 entretoises (article 3 – S0985 – 4mm de long) sur le filetage exposé de chaque boulon, avant de serrer dans les trous filetés sous le sous cadre, voir photo 3.
- Une fois le support d'échappement sur la moto, assurez vous que la partie inférieure du support d'échappement soit à l'extérieur du support de fixation d'échappement, puis insérer le boulon M8 x 55mm (article 4) avec une rondelle M8 (article 5) dans le trou du support de fixation d'échappement puis dans le support d'échappement, avant d'insérer une rondelle M8 (article 5) et un écrou M8 (article 6) onto sur le filetage de chaque boulon puis serrer légèrement, voir photo 4.
- Veiller à ce que le support d'échappement soit correctement monté avant de serrer les 3 boulons.
- Assurez-vous qu'aucune partie ne puisse entrer en contact lorsque la moto sera en route. Cela pourrait créer des dommages à la moto. (Ce point est particulièrement important si vous utilisez un pot d'échappement qui n'est pas d'origine).

Il est de votre responsabilité de vous assurer qu'aucune partie de l'ensemble support de pot d'échappement n'entre en contact avec une autre partie de la moto. Ne pas prendre la route sans avoir fait ces vérifications. Compresser l'amortisseur arrière pour jauger de cet aspect par exemple (si le design de la moto le permet).

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
