



FITTING INSTRUCTIONS

Please note that the way the kit is packed does not necessarily represent the way of mounting to the bike

- Undo the nut on the lower front engine bolt (the one that goes right through the engine).
- Take the R&G replacement engine bar and, using a soft hammer, knock out the OEM bolt, leaving it with equal amounts protruding from either side of the frame.
- Slide the spacer with the machined flat on it over the engine bar on the LHS with the smaller diameter towards the bike, followed by the shorter of the two protectors.
- Take one of the 10mm washers and slide it over the end of the engine bar, then start one of the nyloc nuts and do up finger tight.
- Repeat this procedure for the RHS using the other spacer and the other protector.
- Tighten both nuts until you feel some compression from inside the protectors. Turn a little more so that you feel the compression increase slightly. Then apply a quarter turn. Do not overtighten as damage can occur to the threads on the bar. Do not exceed 40nm of torque.
