



FITTING INSTRUCTIONS FOR LP0060BK LICENCE PLATE BRACKET SUZUKI B-KING 2007-



Please note that the way the kit is packed does not necessarily represent the way of mounting to the bike

Please note that in cases where kits are packed with rubber washers holding the components onto the bolt – *the rubber washers should be thrown away!*

- Remove seat, pillion seat and rear seat cowling (to remove cowling you will have to disconnect key operated pillion seat release wire from catch mechanism).
- Disconnect wiring plug located just under left side at back of rider's seat (licence plate light).
- Undo and remove 4 bolts holding OEM licence plate bracket from underneath.
- Drop OEM licence plate bracket down carefully until licence plate light wiring loom is free.
- If not already fitted, fit new rear light to new licence plate bracket and secure ensuring licence plate LEDs are pointing so as to illuminate licence plate, when secure remove excess threaded studs using hack-saw or side cutters.
- We suggest cutting OEM wiring plug and connecting to new rear light using supplied connectors as follows:

New Wires

RED -----
YELLOW -----
BLACK -----

OEM Wires

WHITE/THIN BLACK STRIPE
BROWN
BLACK/THIN WHITE STRIPE

- **SEE PICTURE BELOW INSTRUCTIONS OF WIRING MODIFICATIONS WITH R&G MINI-INDICATORS.**
- If fitting OEM indicators remove from OEM licence plate bracket.
- If fitting after market mini indicators we suggest cutting OEM plugs and connecting to new indicators using supplied connectors. (Fit OEM or after-market indicators to new tail-tidy)
- If fitting R&G mini-indicators (R&G product code RG370) you will need to fit in line resistors (R&G product code RGR0001) use rubber blanking plugs to fill the redundant holes (supplied in kit)
- Offer up new licence plate bracket as original while feeding wires through original routing .
- Using the four new button head bolts secure new licence plate bracket to bike (from underneath as original), reconnect wiring plugs.
- Check rear light and indicators are working.
- Refit rear seat cowling making sure to reconnect key operated pillion seat release wire to catch mechanism.
- Refit pillion seat.

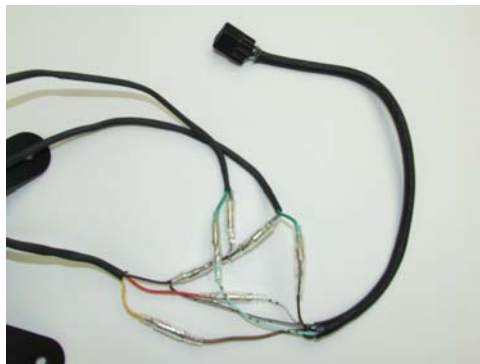

- Refit rider's seat.
- Check operation of all lights before use.
- Refit licence plate.
- **IMPORTANT: IF FITTING A FULL-SIZE LICENCE PLATE AND PLACING IT FAR DOWN ON THE LICENCE PLATE HANGER, THERE IS A SMALL CHANCE OF THE LICENCE PLATE HITTING THE BACK WHEEL UNDER HEAVY LOAD AND OVER LARGE BUMPS IN THE ROAD. IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO CHECK FOR THIS POSSIBILITY AND TAKE AVOIDING ACTION. FAILURE TO CHECK THIS COULD RESULT IN SERIOUS INJURY.**



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
